September 1948 New Keeper For Long Point Light

January 1909

Messrs. Smith and Lopez, light-keepers at Long Point and Race Point respectively are to exchange positions, it is said, they transfer January 14th. Mr. Smith was formerly keeper at Long Point, but has been stationed at the Race Point lighthouse the past three or four years.

February 12, 1873 Sale of Government Property

The property belonging to the U. S. Government on Long Point was disposed of at public auction last Saturday. The barracks, etc., were sold.—John W. Atwood was the principal buyer, though small lots were sold to other parties.
