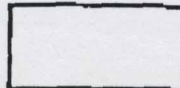


Dear Manager Bergman:
